The Chester County Sheriff's Office is dedicated to assisting crime victims. We strive to help those who are hurting put the pieces of their lives back together by providing various types of services as noted below (*please note this is not an all-inclusive list*).

- Provide victims with a free copy of the law enforcement incident report
- Assist crime victims in filling out the Crime Victim Compensation Application
- Make referrals as warranted based upon the victim's needs
- Provide courtroom accompaniment for crime victims as requested
- Assist crime victims in filling out the Victim Impact Statement as requested
- Provide and or assist in restraining orders
- Provide crime victims with crisis intervention
- Provide follow up to crime victims about their case as warranted

The Chester County Sheriff's Office Law Enforcement Victim Advocate will assess each crime victim's needs. Based upon those needs, appropriate services will be rendered. As needed, the advocate will collaborate and network with resources locally and statewide to ensure that the victim's needs are met.
